- Most often work with people as they go or return to court. Once a person does an intake and is verified to be eligible then they are placed on a wait list. Once someone is on the waitlist we're there for them as a sort of safety net. People are instructed to call us when they get a court date and we try to assign them an advocate who will meet with them, work out the financial assistance aspect, and accompany them to that court date. If the landlord decides not to follow through on things then after a length of time (right now about a year) they'd rise to the top of the wait list. But again, the vast majority of people we work with have court dates which we're accompanying them to.
